Read through our guidelines and then fill in the application form. Give as much information and supporting evidence as you can. We may ask you to attend a short interview to help us asses your application. We'll let you know (normally within 6 weeks) if your application has been successful.

Terms and Conditions

- 1 The CA Bursary is available to practitioners from any area of the arts, provided they live in Crowborough or the surrounding area.
- 2 You must be at least 18 years old at the time of application. There is no upper age limit.
- 3 You must be a current member of Crowborough Arts to be eligible. However, you may join CA at the time of application, for the sum of £15.00 for one year's membership.
- 4 For 2017/18, a maximum of £500 may be granted to any single applicant, or to any single project, should more than one applicant be involved.
- 5 A specific sum will be set aside for bursaries each year, running from the beginning of August to the end of July. Once this sum has been allocated, applicants will have to wait for the start of the next year to be considered for a bursary.
- 6 The bursary cannot be used as part payment towards any further education costs, eg university fees.
- 7 The bursary can however be used towards a specialist course, as long as it has a clear benefit to the applicant's development in his or her chosen field of art.
- 8 We will require proof of costings for your project and may choose to fund part or all of the sum requested, up to the maximum of £500.
- 9 No application can be considered without a fully completed Bursary application form
- 10 The decision of the CA Bursary Panel is final.
